



Improve recruitment, retention and management outcomes as well as help increase organizational maturity.




- PM Practitioners, schedulers, team leads or any user of Microsoft Office Project 2007 standalone.

- These individuals may be involved in or responsible for scheduling, estimating, coordinating, controlling, budgeting, and staffing projects.
- Designed to help equip users who may want to manage project schedules more efficiently.





- Project managers or any user of Microsoft Office Project Professional 2007 and Project Server 2007 who manage and support projects in an Enterprise Project Management (EPM) environment.
- Individuals managing projects in the EPM environment, including project and nonproject efforts, risks, issues, documents, task progress, and timesheets.

Target Audiences of Each Certification (Cont.)



- Project managers, program managers, members of the project management office, or participating in the deployment of an EPM solution






